





Examples of LEA activity in Member States








Metal theft toolkit

- Developed by West Yorkshire Police and British Transport Police
- Provides information to front line officers on prevention and deterrence and prosecuting offenders
- Presented at the third Pol-PRIMETT EUG meeting
- Translated for use by LEAs participating in Pol-PRIMETT









Operation Tornado

- Evidence of identity required from individuals selling metal for cash:
 - UK photocard driving licence
 - Passport supported by a utility bill
- Documents retained for LEA inspection
- Encouraged to enhance CCTV systems to record vehicles and individuals









Operation Tornado outcomes

- 60% reduction in metal theft
- Reduction in recyclers willing to take suspicious metal
- Co-ordinated enforcement and improved efficiency
- Developed multi agency strategies
- Created a regional intelligence picture





Operazione Titano II - results

- 21 arrests
- €26 million confiscated
- 26 HGVs seized
- Assets from 4 companies seized
- 8 cars seized
- 8 houses repossessed
- Seized in excess of 10 tonnes of scrap metal









Greek LEA activity

Following the Pol-PRIMETT EUG meeting in Athens, Greece a national metal theft reduction group was formed by:

- OTE (telecommunication)
- OSE (rail)
- Hellenic Police

The group analysed BTP's Fusion Intelligence Unit and plans to develop an equivalent unit









Spanish LEA activity

- Installed mechanisms to detect metal theft in vulnerable areas
 Information sent to district and national police units for analysis
- Conducted surveillance of metal theft hotspots
- Developed a specialised police unit to protect the environment the Green Patrol
- The Green Patrol conduct inspections of scrap yards to ensure metal is stored in compliance with environmental legislation
- Held a DNA solutions workshop for over 70 delegates to identify implementation solutions





Campo Seguro Operation (Operation Safety Camp)

- Coordinated by Guarda Nacional Republicana
- Nationwide operation to inform and alert farmers on the issue of metal theft
- Held meetings and information sessions with farmer associations and individual farmers
- Conducted door-to-door interviews with farmers
- Produced hand-outs
