Pol-PRIMETT II (Police - Private Partnership to Tackle Metal Theft II) is a two year, co-funded EU project led by the National Crime Agency. **Pol-PRIMETT II** builds on the success of the first Pol-PRIMETT project which finished in September 2013.

Pol-PRIMETT II will develop and expand the existing public - private partnership focusing on six key areas:

- Understanding the involvement of organised crime groups
- Identifying legislation and voluntary codes of practice
- Developing, sharing and raising awareness of good practice on preventing and deterring metal theft
- Identifying gaps in knowledge and intelligence
- Encouraging public-private collaboration
- Sharing Pol-PRIMETT II's findings and results with stakeholders from across the EU

Pol-PRIMETT II will hold three Expert User Group (EUG) meetings a year across Europe to enable the public and private sectors to identify and share good practice to tackle metal theft.



Each meeting will include action-based workshops focused on key issues highlighted by EUG members.
