Joint Call for Actions against Metal Theft at European Level

Metal Theft

- Organised cross-border crime
- Disruption of vital infrastructure services
- Economic losses for businesses and society
- Impact on the quality of services
- Potential risks for the safety

Joint Call for Actions against Metal Theft at European Level

- Legislative action
- Coordinated action and data collection
- Dissuasive action

Legislative action - metal waste and scrap

- Proper implementation and enforcement of existing legislation
- Prohibit uncontrolled management
- New measures: identification of buyers and sellers → efficient and effective investigations and prosecution

Coordinated action and data collection

- Enhanced international coordination and cooperation between law enforcement authorities
- Better exchange of data

Dissuasive action

- Common definitions and sanctions → penalties proportional to the impact and cost of the crime
- Awareness-raising campaigns and training sessions for judicial authorities
